Program

- Swimmers will be divided into groups, Junior Wavemakers, Wavemakers, Swim Skills and Swim Club, based on your registration form.
- Please meet by the blue cubbies in between the girls locker room and the lifeguard station.
- Coaches will be assessing swimmers on the first day of classes to make sure swimmers are in the appropriate level by skill and age.
- All practices are 3:30-4:15
- We do not have classes on Pro-D days or stat holidays.
- A Tyee coach can meet children in grades 3, 4 and 5 outside the gym after school and walk with them to the pool.
- Children in lower grades must make their own way to the pool but are more than welcome to walk with the group if accompanied by an adult.
- It is parents responsibility to pick up their children at 4 :15, Tyee cannot be responsible for children after this time.

- **Fees**

- \$40 for 8 lessons
- Cheques are preferred and are payable to Tyee Aquatic Club but we do accept cash.
- Cheque scan be dropped off at the front desk of Crystal Pool or mailed to, 2275 Quadra St, Victoria, V8T 4C4.
- Payment must be made before or on the first day of lessons.
- We do have access to some jumpstart funding although it is limited. If you need financial assistance please email Kylie.

Learning Groups

The following are general **guidelines** for group placement: all final decisions on group placement will be made by Tyee coaching staff:

Junior Wavemaker • minimum age 3 • must be able to submerge head classes are limited to 6 swimmers/coach

Wavemaker • retrieve object from 1.5m depth and 3m distance • flutter kick on back • classes limited to 9 swimmers/coach

Swim Skills (TSS)

• swim with consistent technique for 100m • swim underwater for 10m • can use flutter kick and dolphin kick for propulsion • classes will have up to 15 swimmers/coach

Swim Club (TSC) • swim freestyle and backstroke with basic technique for 300m • use basic dolphin and whip kick for propulsion • understands how to use the pace clock • can tumble and rotate in the water
